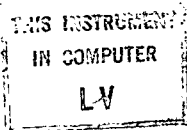

**FINAL ORDER ON PARTIES' JOINT MOTION TO MAKE COURT RECORDS CONFIDENTIAL**

Petitioner, Steven Patterson and respondent, Jennifer Patterson filed their Parties' Joint Motion to Make Court Records Confidential and now it is adjudged that:

1. The parties' have established that confidentiality of the information identified on the attached list is necessary to protect interests under Rule 2.420 to avoid and prevent substantial injury to one or more of them because there is other litigation pending and threatened in which this information could be used by third parties to abuse them and such use of the information would be unrelated to government or judicial accountability or first amendment rights. Additionally, both ZOM Holding, Inc. and FLOR USA Holding, Inc. are innocent third parties in this dissolution case who have a common law right of privacy in their financial affairs.
2. The information identified on the attached list is hereby conditionally sealed meaning it shall be disclosed whenever necessary for government or judicial accountability or to anyone having a proper first amendment right to the information.
3. There is no less restrictive measure available to protect these interests and the degree, duration and manner of confidentiality ordered herein are no broader than necessary to protect these interests.

4. All other papers in the court file and the case progress docket shall otherwise remain available to the public.

5. Counsel for the parties shall execute and deliver to the Clerk of Court a paper substantially in the form attached which the Clerk of Court shall publish on her website and the Court's website for a period of 15 days and she shall affix a copy of the final order on the outside of the court record.

6. The Clerk of Court is hereby authorized to unseal any materials sealed pursuant to the final order for the purpose of filing, microfilming or imaging files or transmitting a record to an appellate tribunal. The materials shall be resealed immediately upon completion of the filing.
