AMENDED ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO MAKE COURT  
RECORDS CONFIDENTIAL PURSUANT TO FLORIDA  
RULE OF JUDICIAL ADMINISTRATION 2.420(c)(9) and (d)(1)

THIS MATTER came before the Court on the Motion of the Respondent pursuant to Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420(c)(9) and (d)(1) for an Order sealing the following information relative to this civil action:

1. The party's name on the progress docket; and
2. The entire court file and the progress docket.

The Court GRANTS the motion as follows:

1. Confidentiality of the court file and progress docket is required to protect the following interests:

- (a) Complying with established public policy set forth in the Florida or United States Constitution or statutes or Florida rules or case law, specifically: Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420(c)(9) and (d)(1); and *Johnson v. State*, 336 So. 2d 93, 95 (Fla. 1976).

2. The Court further finds that no less restrictive measure is available to protect this interest, and that the degree, duration and manner of confidentiality ordered herein are no broader

than necessary to protect the interest.

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that:

The Clerk of the Circuit Court is hereby directed to seal immediately the following materials related to this matter and to keep such materials from public access:

1. The Respondent's name on the progress docket. On the public progress docket, the Clerk of the Circuit Court shall substitute the following for the Respondent's name: JANE DOE. Further, the Clerk shall ensure that the Respondent's name is redacted from all public materials in the file and that the final judgment is recorded in a manner that does not reveal the identity of the Respondent.


2. The entire court file. The case number, however, shall remain public.

It is further ORDERED that any materials sealed pursuant to this Order may otherwise be disclosed only to the Court, and if necessitated for work purposes, court staff, the Clerk of Court and Clerk's staff, and to the parties or their attorneys of record or by further order of the Court.

It is further **ORDERED** that the Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Order in accordance with rule 2.420(d)(4) of the Rules of Judicial Administration and to affix a copy of this Order on the outside of the court record.


