The role performs a variety of clerical tasks, such as:

- Recording payment of fees and fines
- Inputting pleadings into our system
- Specialized tasks (like marriage ceremonies)





Call Center employees use special support headsets to answer calls as swiftly and efficiently as possible for customers.




Some deputy clerks might perform specialized tasks, such as helping people apply for their passports!

We're the first point of contact for all the calls, and what we do is we support and assist the different branches.
