ORDER TO OPEN SAFE DEPOSIT BOX

On the petition of \_\_\_\_\_ for an order to open safe deposit  
box number \_\_\_\_\_ leased or coleased to \_\_\_\_\_  
deceased, by \_\_\_\_\_, as lessor, the court  
finding that satisfactory proof of the death of the decedent has been presented, and that petitioner is  
entitled to the benefits of Florida Statutes Section 655.935, it is

ADJUDGED that \_\_\_\_\_, the lessor, is  
directed to allow petitioner to open and examine the contents of the safe deposit box leased or coleased  
to the decedent by the lessor, in the presence of an officer of the lessor, and the lessor is directed to  
deliver:

1. To the court having probate jurisdiction in the county where the lessor is located, any  
writing purporting to be a will or codicil of the decedent or a writing described in Section 732.515 of the  
Florida Probate Code and any writing purporting to identify devisees of tangible property;

2. To petitioner, any writing purporting to be a deed to a burial plot or to give burial  
instructions;

3. To the beneficiary named therein, any document purporting to be an insurance policy on  
the life of the decedent.

No other contents shall be removed pursuant to this order.

The officer of the lessor shall make a complete copy of any document removed and delivered and  
place that copy, together with a memorandum of delivery identifying the name of the officer, the person to  
whom the document was delivered, and the date of delivery, in the safe deposit box leased or coleased  
by the decedent.

The lessor may charge a reasonable fee to cover costs incurred in complying with this Order.
