**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DETERMINE CONFIDENTIALITY OF
COURT RECORDS**

THIS MATTER came before the Court on the Defendants' June 18 2026,
Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records. The Court, having reviewed
the court file, the Motion, and being otherwise fully advised of the premises, finds
that it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

1. The Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records is
GRANTED.
2. This is a Complex Business Litigation matter.
3. Confidentiality of the subject records is required to:

- (a) Prevent a serious threat and imminent threat to the fair, impartial, and orderly administration of justice;
- (b) Protect trade secrets;
- (c) Avoid substantial injury to innocent third parties;
- (d) Avoid substantial injury to a party by disclosure of matters protected by a common law or privacy right not general inherent in the specific type of proceeding sought to be closed; and
- (e) Comply with established public policy set forth in the Florida Constitution and Florida case law.

4. No parties' names are made confidential by this Order.

5. The progress docket in this case is not to be made confidential, and this Court will specify when any document on that docket will be confidential.

6. The Court finds that: (a) the degree, duration, and manner of confidentiality ordered by the Court is no broader than necessary to protect the interests set forth in paragraph 3, above, and no less restrictive measures are available to protect the interests set forth in paragraph 3, above.

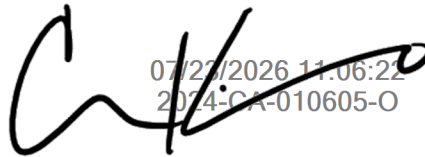
7. The Court hereby directs the Clerk of Court to seal Defendants' June 17, 2026, Reply to Plaintiff's Response in Opposition to Defendants' Motion for Summary Judgment.

8. The Court hereby declares the document specified in paragraph 7 of this Court to be Confidential under Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420.

9. Only the parties to this case, and their legal counsel of record in this case may view the documents being sealed by this Order.

10. The Clerk of Court is hereby directed to, within ten (10) days following the entry of this Order, post a copy of the Order on the Clerk's website and in a prominent, public location in the Orange County, Florida Courthouse at 425 N. Orange Avenue, Orlando, Florida 32801. The Order shall remain so posted on the Clerk's website and at the Orange County Courthouse for no less than 30 days.
